Awarded by Korean Language and Culture Program in the East Asian Languages and Literatures Department through the generous funding from Professor Emeritus Young-Key Kim Renaud, this scholarship provides 3 credit course tuition applied to KOR 3105 or above, depending on the current level of the awardee.

Eligibility and Requirement

1. The applicant must currently be enrolled in a Korean language course at GW with a grade higher than a B-.
2. The applicant must submit a 1.5-2 page Statement of Intent in English describing a long-term interest in Korean studies including motivation, passion, and plans for the application of Korean language skills in the student's career path at GW and beyond.
